LEE BROCKINGTON : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Lee Brockington as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Brockington currently holds a School Business Administrator Certificate of Eligibility, issued in May 1996 and a School Business Administrator certificate, issued in December 2003. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Brockington presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to an 18 month suspension of his certificates. Brockington did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of December 10, 2015, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 10th day of December 2015, Lee Brockington's School Business Administrator Certificate of Eligibility and School Business Administrator certificate are hereby **SUSPENDED** for a period of 18 months, effective immediately. It is further **ORDERED** that Brockington return the above-mentioned suspended certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the effective date of the suspension.
