PAMELA LACK : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Pamela Lack as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Lack currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-5 Certificate of Eligibility, issued in July 2008, a Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, issued in July 2008 and Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-5 and Teacher of Students with Disabilities certificates, both issued in September 2009. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Lack presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a two-month suspension of her certificates. Lack did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of September 16, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 16th day of September 2016, Pamela Lack's Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-5 Certificate of Eligibility, Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and her Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-5 and Teacher of Students with Disabilities certificates are hereby SUSPENDED for a period of two months, pursuant to the terms of the agreement.
