BANMALI BANERJEE : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Banmali Banerjee as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Banerjee currently holds a Teacher of Mathematics Certificate of Eligibility, issued in May 2002, a Teacher of Mathematics certificate, issued in June 2004 and a Supervisor certificate, issued in September 2014. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Banerjee presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to a three-year suspension of his certificates. Banerjee did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of January 19, 2017, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 19th day of January 2017, Banmali Banerjee's Teacher of Mathematics Certificate of Eligibility and his Teacher of Mathematics and Supervisor certificates are hereby SUSPENDED for three years, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Banerjee return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
