JONATHAN H. JASINSKI : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of January 19, 2018, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Bergen County Prosecutor's Office had forwarded regarding Jonathan H. Jasinski. On September 28, 2017, Jasinski pled guilty to Endangering the Welfare of Children-Sexual Conduct and Endangering the Welfare of Children-Possessing/Viewing of Child Pornography. As a result of the conviction, Jasinski was disqualified from public school employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:6-7.1 *et seq.* Jasinski currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in January 2020.

Jasinski agreed to relinquish his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of January 19, 2018, the Board voted to accept Jasinski's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 19th day of January 2018, it is therefore ORDERED that Jonathan H. Jasinski's Substitute Credential is hereby revoked, effective immediately.
