BARBARA PYNE : ORDER OF REVOCATION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Barbara Pyne as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Pyne currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School, Teacher of the Handicapped and Supervisor certificates and a Principal Certificate of Eligibility. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Pyne presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to the relinquishment of her certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences, pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-4.7*. Pyne did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of November 1, 2018, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 1st day of November 2018, Barbara A. Pyne's Teacher of Elementary School, Teacher of the Handicapped and Supervisor certificates and her Principal Certificate of Eligibility are hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Pyne return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
