MD K. HUDA : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of November 1, 2018, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that MD K. Huda had submitted pursuant to an Order to Show Cause that had been issued to him. On June 2, 2017, Huda pled guilty to Cruelty and Neglect of Children. On November 3, 2017, he was sentenced to 30 months' probation and ordered to attend counseling and complete 200 hours of community service. As a result of his conviction, Huda was disqualified from public school employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:6-7.1 *et seq.* Huda currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in July 2021.

Huda agreed to relinquish his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of November 1, 2018, the Board voted to accept Huda's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 1st day of November 2018, it is therefore ORDERED that MD K. Huda's Substitute Credential be revoked, effective immediately.
