At its meeting of June 28, 2019, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that William D. Armor had submitted pursuant to an Order to Show Cause that had been issued to him as to why his teaching certificate should not be revoked. In May 2018, Armor pled guilty in Pennsylvania to Corruption of Minors, a third-degree felony. On August 28, 2018, he was sentenced to 30 days to 23 ¹/₂ months in prison, followed by two years of probation. He was also ordered to register as a sex offender for 15 years. Armor also surrendered his Pennsylvania teaching certificate in May 2018. In New Jersey, Armor currently holds a Teacher of Mathematics certificate.

Armor agreed to relinquish his certificate with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of June 28, 2019, the Board voted to accept Armor's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 28th day of June 2019, William D. Armor's Teacher of Mathematics certificate is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Armor return the above-mentioned certificate to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
