ANTHONY R. LENTINE, JR. : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Anthony R. Lentine, Jr. as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Lentine currently holds a Teacher of Elementary Certificate, Teacher of Handicapped Certificate, Teacher of Food Services Certificate, Supervisor Certificate, Principal Certificate of Eligibility, Principal Certificate, and Chief School Administrator Certificate of Eligibility.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Lentine presented a proposal to the Board in which he agreed to a three (3) month suspension of his certificates. Lentine did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of May 14, 2020, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 2020, it is therefore ordered that Anthony R. Lentine Jr.'s above-referenced certificates are hereby suspended for a period of three (3) months, commencing immediately. It is further ORDERED that Lentine return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
