ROBERT D. KOHN : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Robert D. Kohn, on December 9, 2022, as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Kohn currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-6 Certificate of Eligibility and a Teacher of Elementary School with Mathematics Specialization in Grades 5-8 Certificate of Eligibility.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Kohn presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to a one-year suspension of his certificates. Kohn did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of November 1, 2024, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 2024, it is therefore ORDERED that Robert D. Kohn's Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-6 Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Elementary School with Mathematics Specialization in Grades 5-8 Certificate of Eligibility are hereby SUSPENDED FOR ONE YEAR, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Kohn return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
