At its meeting of December 6, 2024, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit it received from Christopher L.C. Kuberiet, First Assistant Prosecutor with the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office, regarding Edward White. White currently holds a Teacher of Carpentry Certificate of Eligibility, issued May 2015, and a Teacher of Carpentry standard certificate, issued August 2017.

White agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of December 6, 2024, the Board voted to accept White's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.10.

White's Teacher of Carpentry Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Carpentry standard certificate are hereby ORDERED RELINQUISHED, with the force and effect of a revocation, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that White return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
