JOSHUA L. ROSENBAUM : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Joshua L. Rosenbaum on November 1, 2019, as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Rosenbaum currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-8 Certificate of Eligibility, issued January 2000; and a Standard Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-8 certificate, issued August 2004.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Rosenbaum presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to a eighteen-month suspension of his certificates. Rosenbaum did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of September 18, 2026, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 18th day of September 2026, it is therefore ORDERED that Joshua L. Rosenbaum's Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-8 Certificate of Eligibility and Standard Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-8 certificate are hereby SUSPENDED for eighteen (18) months, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Rosenbaum return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
