TINASIAH MITCHELL : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Tinasiah Mitchell on May 23, 2025, as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Mitchell currently holds a Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility, issued April 2022.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Mitchell presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a two-year suspension of her certificates. Mitchell did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of September 18, 2026, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 18th day of September 2026, it is therefore ORDERED that Tinasiah Mitchell's Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility is hereby SUSPENDED for two (2) years, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Mitchell return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
