KHADEJA WILEY : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Khadeja Wiley on May 22, 2025, as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Wiley currently holds an Instructional Substitute credential, issued October 23, 2023, expiring October 23, 2028.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Wiley presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a thirty-day suspension of her certificates. Wiley did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of September 18, 2026, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 18th day of September 2026, it is therefore ORDERED that Khadeja Wiley's Instructional Substitute credential is hereby SUSPENDED for thirty (30) days, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Wiley return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
