KIMARA RAMSEY : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Kimara Ramsey on December 6, 2024, as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Ramsey currently holds a Teacher of Preschool through Grade 3 Certificate of Eligibility (CE), issued in August 2001; a Standard Teacher of Preschool through Grade 3 certificate, issued in May 2006; a Principal CE, issued in April 2009; a Standard Supervisor certificate, issued in September 2011; and a Standard Principal certificate, issued in August 2016.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Ramsey presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a one-month suspension of her certificates. Ramsey did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of May 21, 2026, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 21st day of May 2026, it is therefore ORDERED that Kimara Ramsey's Teacher of Preschool through Grade 3 Certificate of Eligibility (CE), Standard Teacher of Preschool through Grade 3 certificate, Principal CE, Standard Supervisor certificate, and Standard Principal certificate are hereby SUSPENDED for one month, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Ramsey return the above-mentioned paper certificates, if issued, to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
