At its November public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following proposals for publication in the Dec. 19, 2016, *New Jersey Register:*

- Readoption without amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:12, Interdistrict Public School Choice;
- Readoption with amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:22, Student Residency; and
- Readoption with amendments of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:23A-16 through 22, Fiscal Accountability, Efficiency and Budgeting Procedures.

The rulemaking for *N.J.A.C.* 6A:12 is related to the rules for the Interdistrict Public School Choice program. The rulemaking for *N.J.A.C.* 6A:22 is related to the rules that govern student residency determinations. The rulemaking for *N.J.A.C.* 6A:23A-16 through 22 is related to rules regarding efficiency and budgeting for public schools and private schools for students with disabilities.

The Acting Commissioner of Education also filed the following proposal for publication in the Dec. 19, 2016, *New Jersey Register:*

• Readoption with amendments of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:23A-1 through 15, Fiscal Accountability, Efficiency and Budgeting Procedures.

The rulemaking for *N.J.A.C.* 6A:23A-16 through 22 is related to rules regarding efficiency and budgeting for public schools.

The four notices of proposal can be viewed on the Administrative Code and Statute section of the <u>Department's website</u>.

Members of the public may send in written comments concerning the proposals by Feb. 17, 2017, via the <u>Department's website</u> or via the mailing or email addresses contained in the notices of proposal.
