At its April or May public meetings, the State Board of Education approved the following proposals for publication in the June 5, 2017, *New Jersey Register*:

- Notice of Proposed Substantial Changes upon Adoption to Proposed Amendments of *N.J.A.C. 6A:16-7.7* and 7.8; and
- Notice of Proposed Substantial Changes upon Adoption to Proposed Amendments of *N.J.A.C. 6A:27-7.13*.

The notice for *N.J.A.C. 6A:16-7.7* and 7.8 is related to proposed amendments of the rules implementing the *Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act*. The notice for *N.J.A.C. 6A:27-7.13* is related to proposed rules for sensors on school buses that would implement Abigail's Law.
