Advisory: Proposed Readoption of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:20, Adult Education Programs, and 6A:27, Student Transportation

Trenton, NJ – At its August 19, 2020 public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemakings for publication in the September 21, 2020 *New Jersey Register:*

- Readoption with amendments of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:20, Adult Education Programs, which sets forth the rules for adult high school and for the awarding of State-issued high school diplomas; and
- Readoption with amendments of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:27, Student Transportation, which sets forth the rules for the transportation of students to and from school and school-related activities, governs contracts for student transportation, and delineates the Department's responsibilities in oversight of student transportation.

The notices of proposal can be viewed in the Department of Education's Administrative Code and Statute webpage.

Members of the public may send written comments concerning the notice by November 20, 2020, via the Department's <u>website</u> or via the mailing or email addresses contained in the notices.
