Advisory: Proposed Readoption of N.J.A.C. 6A:14, Special Education

Trenton, NJ – At its April 1, 2020, public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemaking for publication in the May 4, 2020, *New Jersey Register:*

• Readoption with amendments of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:14, Special Education, which sets forth the rules for the provision of a free and appropriate public education to students with disabilities.

The notice of proposal can be viewed in the Department of Education's Administrative Code and Statute <u>webpage</u>.

Public testimony on the notice is tentatively scheduled to be held on Wednesday, July 1, 2020.

Members of the public may also send in written comments concerning the notice by July 3, 2020, via the Department's <u>website</u> or via the mailing or email addresses contained in the notice.
