• N.J.A.C. 6A:11 sets forth the rules for charter schools in the State and implements the Charter School Program Act, N.J.S.A. 18A:36A-1 et seq. The chapter primarily affects charter schools, charter school districts of residence, applicants for a charter school, and students seeking enrollment in a charter school and other interested parties.

• The last rulemaking of this chapter was in 2017 and it included several substantive amendments and new rules.
