

Adoption Resolution March 5, 2025

Resolution in Recognition of Gifted and Talented Students Month in New Jersey

Whereas, the Strengthening Gifted and Talented Education Act was signed into law on January 13, 2020; and

Whereas, shortly thereafter, the New Jersey Department of Education established the Strengthening Gifted and Talented Education Advisory Committee, consisting of five subcommittees to address Law Implementation, Identification, Programming, the Intersectionality of Cognitive and Affective Needs, and Professional Development to best identify and serve the needs of gifted students; and

Whereas, the New Jersey Department of Education collaborates with the Advisory Committee, various New Jersey education organizations, and gifted and talented education experts from across the country to provide educators with technical assistance on how to best support gifted and twice-exceptional students; and

Whereas, it is the work of these collaborative efforts that support Statewide and local education agencies' efforts in meeting the needs of gifted and twice-exceptional students, so they are provided the opportunity to fulfill their academic potential; now, therefore be it

Resolved, that the New Jersey State Board of Education and the Commissioner of Education recognize the month of March as "Gifted and Talented Students Month in New Jersey" and honor the gifted and talented students of New Jersey, as well as their parents, teachers, and school leaders who are working to ensure that students have the resources and opportunities they need to succeed.
