Empowering New Educators: Building Community and Practices during the New Teacher Academy (LRC-South)

About the Learning Resource Centers

The Learning Resource Center (LRC) Network is a New Jersey Department of Education initiative funded by IDEA Part B. With four centers across the state, it serves as a comprehensive resource for special education, offering free instructional materials, technical assistance, professional development, and policy guidance to families and educators of students with disabilities.

Spotlighting the New Teacher Academy

The Learning Resource Center-South (LRC-S) hosts an annual New Teacher Academy (NTA) Professional Learning Community (PLC) for early career educators in New Jersey. This free program, open to teachers in their first three years, begins with a three-day summer academy in mid-August. The academy focuses on building community, developing culturally responsive practices, and implementing inclusive instructional strategies. Throughout the year, participants engage in monthly PLC meetings to support ongoing professional growth.

Participants describe the NTA as empowering and supportive, valuing the connections made with peers, diverse perspectives gained, and increased confidence in supporting students with varied learning needs. The program also offers leadership development opportunities, with some members returning as facilitators in subsequent years.
