This matter arises from an allegation that John E. Herbert, Jr., Supervisor of Information Technology, Office of Information Technology, improperly accepted gifts and benefits, including meals, boat rides and paid vacations, from an employee of Hitachi Data Systems (“Hitachi”), a State vendor, and that Herbert had an obligation to recuse himself from official matters involving Hitachi.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g)*.
