

## No Longer Eligible for NJ FamilyCare?

Quality, Affordable Health Insurance Options Are Available!

For the past few years, reviews of Medicaid eligibility were paused to prevent individuals from losing their health coverage during the COVID-19 pandemic. As of April 1, 2023, states restarted those reviews per federal law. This means some residents may lose their NJ FamilyCare (Medicaid/CHIP) coverage.

If you or someone in your household are no longer eligible for NJ FamilyCare, there are other free and low-cost health plan options for you and your family.

If a member is no longer eligible, NJ FamilyCare will send a notification about loss of coverage.

You may qualify to enroll in a health plan through GetCovered.NJ.gov. If you qualify you will have a limited time to enroll. Choose a plan within 60 days after NJ FamilyCare coverage ends to avoid a gap in insurance coverage.

Get Covered New Jersey is the state's Official
Health Insurance Marketplace, where
individuals and families can easily shop for and
buy health coverage. All GetCoveredNJ plans
cover doctor visits, prescriptions, emergency
care, and more. You can use GetCoveredNJ to
compare health plans and calculate costs, and to
choose the plan that works best for you and your
family.
