The Department of the Treasury is pleased to help support the goals of the Governor's Executive Order #4 to increase awareness of and enrollment in the Affordable Care Act (ACA) marketplace in order to ensure as many New Jersey residents as possible have access to affordable health coverage.

To that end, Treasury has taken the following actions to further these goals:

- We have created a web button that links to the Department of Banking and Insurance's clearinghouse for ACA enrollment:
 http://www.state.nj.us/dobi/getcovered/index.html#marketplace. This button has been placed prominently on Treasury's home page, as well as on a number of our public-facing division landing pages, including: Pension and Benefits, Taxation, Revenue and Enterprise Services, and
- Treasury's Division of Pension and Benefits promotes ACA enrollment as an alternative to COBRA and C375 enrollment on several of their online fact sheets geared towards current and former participants and dependents in the State Health Benefits Program and the School Employees' Health Benefits Program:
