



**Minutes of the Government Records Council
December 18, 2018 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 1:45 p.m. in Conference Room 129 of the Department of Community Affairs, Trenton, New Jersey. In attendance were: Christopher Huber, Esq. (designee of Department of Education Commissioner, Dr. Lamont Repollet), Jason Martucci, Esq. (designee of Department of Community Affairs Commissioner, Lt. Governor Sheila Y. Oliver), and Steven Ritardi, Esq. (Public Member).

Absent: Robin Berg Tabakin, Esq. (Chairwoman)

Also, in attendance were GRC Staff: Frank F. Caruso (Communications Specialist/Resource Manager), Rosemond Bordzoe (Secretary), Samuel Rosado (Staff Attorney), and Deputy Attorney General Susan Scott.

Mr. Ritardi called for a motion to go into closed session. Mr. Martucci made a motion, which was seconded by Mr. Huber. The Council adopted the motion by a unanimous vote.

The Council met in closed session pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b)(1) to conduct an *in camera* review in the following matters:

- Matthew Drange v. Camden County Office of Archives and Records Management (2015-265)
- Luis Rodriguez v. Kean University (2017-90)

Mr. Rosado introduced GRC Complaint No. 2016-265 to the Council. The Council reviewed the records at issue here *in camera* and agreed with the conclusions as written.

Mr. Caruso introduced GRC Complaint No. 2017-90 to the Council. The Council reviewed the record at issue *in camera* and discussed the proposed findings. The Council debated the applicability of the exemptions set forth by the agency, and ultimately agreed to the conclusions as written.

Mr. Ritardi called for a motion to end the closed session. Mr. Huber made a motion, which was seconded by Mr. Martucci. The Council adopted the motion by a unanimous vote. The closed session meeting concluded at 2:03 p.m.
