



**Minutes of the Government Records Council
November 9, 2021 – Closed Session**

The Council convened in closed session at 2:11 p.m. telephonically. In attendance were: Robin Berg Tabakin, Esq. (Chairwoman), Salma Chand, Esq. (designee of Department of Education Acting Commissioner, Dr. Angelica Allen-McMillan), Gina Trish (designee of Department of Community Affairs Commissioner, Lt. Governor Sheila Y. Oliver), and Steven Ritardi, Esq. (Public Member)

Also, in attendance were GRC Staff: Frank F. Caruso (Executive Director), Rosemond Bordzoe (Secretary), Samuel Rosado (Staff Attorney), and Deputy Attorney General Debra Allen. John Stewart (Mediator) was absent.

Ms. Berg Tabakin called for a motion to go into closed session. Ms. Chand made a motion, which was seconded by Mr. Ritardi. The Council adopted the motion by a unanimous vote.

The Council met in closed session pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b)(7) and N.J.A.C. 5:105-2.8(g) to review records *in camera* and receive legal advice in the following matters:

- Deliberate and receive legal advice on GRC's draft regulations proposal (N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b)(7)).

The Council reviewed, discussed, and received legal advice regarding possible changes to the GRC's regulations, which are set to expire in April 2022.

Ms. Berg Tabakin called for a motion to end the closed session. Ms. Trish made a motion, which was seconded by Ms. Chand. The Council adopted the motion by a unanimous vote. The closed session meeting concluded at 3:53 p.m.
