Dear Parent/Guardian,

You are receiving this letter because your child's immunization record is incomplete/missing vaccination documentation in the New Jersey Immunization Information System (NJIS). NJIS is a free, confidential online registry that can help parents and health care providers keep track of immunizations given from birth through adulthood. NJ law requires health care providers who provide vaccines to children under 7 years of age to enter them into the NJIS, so you may want to talk to your child's provider about entering your child's missing vaccinations.

There are many benefits to participating in NJIS. It helps health care providers know what vaccines you and/or your child need for the next appointment, which is convenient and can save you time and money. NJIS also serves as an official immunization record for child care, school, employment, travel, or other instances where vaccination records are required.
