## **ANTIGEN-SPECIFIC EXEMPTION LIST**

In accordance with New Jersey Administrative Codes (N.J.A.C. 8:57-4.3 and N.J.A.C. 8:57-4.4), medical and religious exemptions can be accepted in lieu of vaccination for attendance in child care/preschool and schools. During a vaccine-preventable disease outbreak, an exempted child may need to be excluded from routine school or child care until he/she is determined to no longer be at risk of developing the disease. Consider using the chart below to easily identify students who are exempt from receiving the following vaccines by marking an "R" for a religious exemption and an "M" for a medical exemption. During an outbreak, this list can help you to determine which students may be susceptible.

In the example below, a student who has an exemption for the MMR vaccine could be susceptible during a measles outbreak if he/she was exposed.
