Proclamation.

WHEREAS, vaccination is proven to be one of the most successful public health interventions by preventing countless cases of disease and disability and saving millions of lives; and

WHEREAS, vaccines not only provide individual protection for those persons who are vaccinated, they can also provide community protection by reducing the spread of disease within a population;

WHEREAS, childhood vaccines protect against serious diseases such as diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), polio, measles, mumps, rubella, Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib), hepatitis B, varicella (chickenpox) and pneumococcal disease, thereby reducing the spread of disease to others in classrooms, childcare centers, and communities; and

WHEREAS, everyone six months of age and older is recommended to receive a yearly flu vaccine; and

WHEREAS, everyone six months of age and older is recommended to receive the COVID-19 vaccine; and

WHEREAS, preteens and teens are recommended to receive vaccines to protect against meningitis, whooping cough; and cancers caused by human papillomavirus (HPV); and

WHEREAS, vaccines are important to protect adults from diseases such as shingles and pneumonia and help prevent the worsening of chronic health conditions; and

WHEREAS, older adults and babies need protection from respiratory syncytial virus (RSV); and

WHEREAS, it is critical for New Jerseyans to maintain routine immunizations to protect individuals and communities from vaccine-preventable diseases and outbreaks; and

WHEREAS, National Immunization Awareness Month is an annual observance held in August to highlight the importance of vaccination for people of all ages;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip D. Murphy, Governor of the State of New Jersey do hereby proclaim:
