New Jersey EMS Advisory Council

New Jersey Association of Paramedic Programs (NJAPP) - Mr. Bober

- Leading Edge 2025 is scheduled for September 10, 2025, at MetLife Stadium
- A prehospital blood administration work group has been established
- Next NJAPP meeting will take place in November during the National Conference on EMS

Basic Life Support (BLS) Sub-Committee - Dr. Satty

- Discussed strategies to reduce the use of lights and sirens during EMS responses, emphasizing the importance of reeducation through EMT Refresher courses and CEVO training. The goal is to reinforce appropriate decision making and minimize unnecessary risks to both patients and clinicians
- Discussed the use of **Doppler devices by BLS providers** to obtain **blood pressure** readings for patients with Left Ventricular Assist Devices (LVADs)

NJ Air Medical Program - Dr. Kuc

- Met in June and reviewed an article focused on interfacility transports, specifically
 examining the benefits of ground transport versus air transport in various clinical
 scenarios
- Next committee meeting is scheduled for next Wednesday

New Jersey EMS Task Force (Task Force) – Dr. Vetrano

- Aided multiple facilities this summer that were forced to evacuate
- A survey has been distributed to task force members to gauge interest and availability for participation in a one-day full scale exercise
- Efforts continue to identify and secure a sustainable funding source

Trauma Council - Dr. Porter

• A new subcommittee on disaster preparedness has been formed

OEMS Report – Mr. Rafferty

- Introduced Michael Estwan and Thomas Livecchi to of the New Jersey Department of Health
- Updated protocols document has been published and distributed.
- The Department is drafting a waiver to authorize a single paramedic pronouncement under certain circumstances after the Board of Medical Examiners (BME) convened on September 13, 2025, with no objections
- The Division of Epidemiology, Environmental and Occupational Health (EEOH) announced that funds are available from the Hepatitis Inoculation Fund to reimburse Hepatitis B inoculations for certain EMTs, firefighters, and police officers
 - Each municipality may receive up to \$5,000 in reimbursement costs. Applications for reimbursement must be received by EEOH no later than June 5, 2026
- During a 5-month period covering April to August, there were 27 pre-hospital whole blood administrations
 - o 16 University Hospital (13 Air, 3 Ground)
 - o 7 Hackensack Meridian Health (2 Air, 5 Ground)
 - 4 Virtua (Ground)
 - o Average time from arrival on scene to administration was 20 minutes
 - o Average patient age was 52
 - o No complications reported: 89% (11% not reporting)

Data – Mr. Seplaki

- 1.3 million records have been submitted in 2025, which is a 3.5% increase from 2024
- The average time of completion for ePCR's in 2025 is 1.74 days which is a decrease from 2024
- NEMSIS 3.5.1 will be released Fall of 2025
- Narcan Leave Behind bags remain available. Those interesting in obtaining bags, please contact Cassandra Angelo
- Introduced Jenny Gerace to of the New Jersey Department of Health
- National Conference on EMS registration is open with discounted rates available thru September 30, 2025

- There has been an increase in RSI due to radio failure

OEMS Education – Mr. Kazar

- Agencies are reminded to review internal policies and reinforce education regarding patient elopements from moving ambulances, emphasizing safety and prevention
- Agency renewals are open for those licenses expiring December 31, 2025
- For agencies constructing a new vehicle, it is recommended that they verify with the OEMS for graphic compliance with applicable regulations
- Agencies should re-evaluate lights and siren usage. A 2024 study by NEMSQA has been posted to the Department's website
- The 2025 EMT Refresher update is currently under final review
- Provided an update to the NREMT and New Jersey learning management and credentialing platforms
- Received a request to review hemostatic spray
 - Discussion ensued with no support for its utilization of hemostatic spray in the pre-hospital environment for EMS
