COMMITTEE REPORTS

OEMS Report – Ms. Gardner

- National Conference on EMS is approaching. Early bird rate of \$350 ends on September 30, 2023
- Notifications to the award nominees were sent last week. The list of nominees has been posted to the conference website
- There are 11 ALS teams and 12 BLS teams from New Jersey, New York, Rhode Island, and Connecticut registered for the SIM Competition
- The Community Service Award is posted to the conference website and is 100% voted on by the public. Voting will close on October 8, 2023
- Welcomed Dr. Kaitlan Baston as Acting Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of

Health

- Over 600 first responders have been trained in Five Minutes to Help and the Naloxone Leave Behind program
- Those who need resources regarding Five Minutes to Help and the Naloxone Leave Behind program can contact Tim Seplaki or Eva Nelson. Resources will soon be made available to the County EMS coordinators to distribute to their agencies
- EMSC and special projects recently conducted a Pediatric Disaster Response Emergency Preparedness training for 86 EMS providers
- EMSC continues to provide monthly educational programs to highlight the pediatric patient. There has been at least 200 providers in each session throughout the year
- The Culture of Safety committee has reconvened. They are focusing on mental health, lifting and moving, and re-evaluating the use of lights & sirens during emergency transports. If anyone is interested in being a part of the committee, please contact Colin Taylor from NJ OEMS
- Current members of this council need to discuss if they want additional memberships, or other individuals to be part of this body. If so, a letter needs to be sent NJ OEMS specifying what position needs to be added and why

OEMS Education – Mr. Kazar

- Christian Rios will be assuming the responsibility of secretary for all Boards and Councils
- Agency licensure has established a new email address, <u>oemsagencylic@doh.nj.gov</u>.
 This email address is to be contacted for anything related to the operations of a licensed agency
- OEMS is in the process of creating a direct phone number for reportable events
- Vehicle graphics need to match the trade name
- Investigators are discovering more vehicles are being left unsecured. It is important to make sure you lock your vehicles. This is a fineable offense and is not best practice
- Investigators are discovering multiple agencies are non-compliant with the regulatory and statutory requirements for crew members
- Stretchers need to be operated by two providers. The Department continues to see an increase of stretcher related incidents
- Agencies starting M-Z, are due for renewal by December 31, 2023

- NREMT Paramedic exam model will change July 1, 2024
- At the end of the June 2023 certification cycle, the Department received 30 new applications for Paramedics wishing to obtain inactive status. Based on new data, the average years of service for those Paramedics was 18 and the average age was 47 years old.
- Since January 1, 2023, the Department has issued the following new credentials and reviewed and approved

- The Department received 25 applicants for the Fall instructor screening session. In addition, there are 10 instructor candidates currently completing the alternative pathway process and 7 awaiting hours
