<u>OEMS Report – Ms. Candace Gardner</u>

- Thank you for a wonderful and successful EMS Week
- Welcomed Paul Jakubowski to OEMS, as a Public Health Representative
- There will be additional positions for Mobile Integrated Health and a State EMS Medical Director posted shortly
- Committee on Accreditation for the EMS Professions (CoAEMSP) will be launching a voluntary Advanced EMT Program accreditation that will start January 1, 2025
- Course approvals are up to date, please refer providers to email Ms. Holmes if there are any questions
- Refresher program evaluation is being overseen by Mr. Kazar at this time, please refer any questions or comments you may have to him

- The OEMS will be routinely updating the list of agencies eligible for EMT Training Fund Reimbursement, found on the Department's website
- Narcan Leave Behind supplies can be placed through the New Jersey Department of Human Services website
- All presenters selected to speak at the 2023 National Conference on EMS have been notified
- Always Ready for Children, is a voluntary program for EMS agencies to be recognized as meeting certain pediatric criteria. EMS agencies may apply for recognition through the Licensing System
- The EMS Task Force will be assisting in working on pediatric readiness and disaster preparedness with hospital coalitions
- Clinical Corner, first series of pediatric educational videos is in the final stages of approval
- Agency Licensing and Inspections are developing a new virtual inspection process
- If you are requesting anyone from the OEMS to attend an event, please make sure to submit a request at least 45 days prior to the date of the event which are posted on the website
- The Department issued a position statement on anti-choking devices, which are
 posted to the website. These devices are and are currently not approved for use
 on any EMS vehicle within the State
- The updated regulations are in the review process. The current regulations will be re-adopted for seven (7) years and repealed once the new regulations have been approved

PUBLIC COMMENT

- Mr. Fischberg:
 - Supports increased reimbursement for EMT refresher, funding may make it difficult to move forward
 - Pediatric posters now reflect weight in kilograms (kg), as such, kg conversion charts should be in every ambulance
- Ms. Vanning:

- Questioned the EMT Instructor process
- Mr. Kazar advised that there are eight (8) micro evaluations tonight. If candidates stayed on track with their required hours, they could potentially be issued their EMT-Instructor tonight. The next screening dates will be in October
- Ms. Neena, on behalf of Plainsboro Rescue Squad:
 - Expressed concerns with being removed from the EMT Training Fund Eligibility list
 - "The Plainsboro Rescue Squad has been in service since 1974 and operates daily, at night, from 6p-6a during the week and 24 hours on weekend nights. The Plainsboro Rescue Squad does not bill patients for service, but the Plainsboro Twp. EMS, which is a different entity that utilizes the Plainsboro Rescue Squad vehicles, is licensed and bills patients for the service provide."
 - Requested the Plainsboro Rescue Squad be reinstated to the EMT Training Fund Eligibility List. As per Mr. Daniel Kazar, the OEMS will further investigate the legalities of the Plainsboro Rescue Squads operation separate from this meeting
