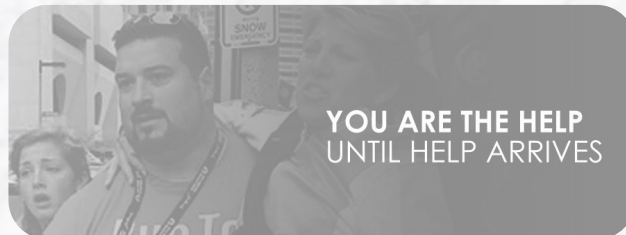


Until Help Arrives
