SFY 2022 Hourly Co-pay Family Cost Participation Tables

Effective: July 1, 2021

(Effective: January 1, 2022

Maximum copay adjusted to match 7.5% provider rate increase)



Family Cost Participation Tables Instructions

1. If a family's income is below 300% Federal Poverty Level (FPL), they will have **no** cost participation. The 300% FPL table below identifies the starting income for assessing family cost participation.

300% FPL Table

Family Size	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
300% FPL	\$52,260	\$65,880	\$79,500	\$93,120	\$106,740	\$120,360	\$133,980

2. A family's co-pay will never exceed the actual hourly cost of service.
3. If the family size is greater than 8, call DOH-NJEIS for the family's monthly cost participation.
4. A family may estimate their co-payment by calculating wages/fees/commissions, interest, dividends, pensions, annuities, IRA withdrawals, and other personal and business income and then using the total, locate that amount on the Family Cost Participation Table and then look under the appropriate family size for the family's estimated hourly co-payment. This only serves as an estimate of the family co-pay pending an NJEIS determined income and co-pay provided through the Family Cost Participation Notice which then serves as the basis for billing.
5. If a family's income exceeds the highest income level on the table, the hourly co-pay will be the actual cost of the service based on the NJEIS Provider Rates. The family's monthly maximum Family Cost Participation will be the maximum monthly family cost participation at \$440,000 plus 0.375% of the family's incremental annual income above \$440,000.

Monthly Billing Worksheet	
1. Enter the hourly co-pay from the table.	
2. Enter the estimated number of hours of service a family will receive in a month.	
3. Calculate the estimated monthly cost of service by multiplying line 1 times 2.	
4. Enter the monthly maximum cost participation from the table.	
5. Take the lesser of line 3, or 4. This is the family's estimated monthly family cost participation.
