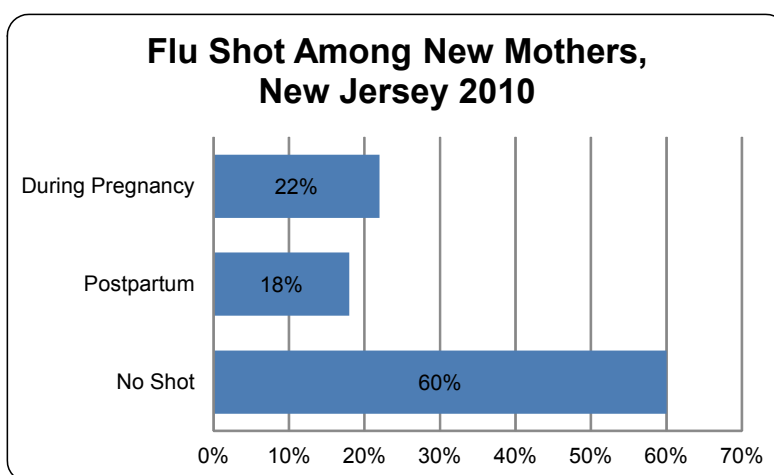

Pregnancy Risk Assessment Monitoring System—A survey for healthier babies in New Jersey

## Did you know that only 22% of new mothers get a seasonal flu shot during pregnancy?



**According to the [New Jersey PRAMS Flu Issue Brief](#), pregnant and postpartum women who are either recommended or offered a flu vaccine by their health care providers are 5 times more likely to be vaccinated than women who are not recommended or offered the vaccine.**

**The percent of new mothers that do not receive a flu shot is highest among minority women.**

Race and Ethnicity	During Pregnancy (%)	Postpartum (%)	No Shot (%)
White, not Hispanic	25	20	55
Black, not Hispanic	21	10	69
Hispanic	16	18	66
Asian, not Hispanic	23	24	53
