

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) works to improve the health of low-income seniors at least 60 years of age by supplementing their diets with nutritious foods provided by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

USDA Foods are pre-packed and distributed to eligible seniors monthly. The contents of the food package may change monthly depending upon what is available from USDA.

Applicants who participate in specific Federal Programs such as, (SNAP, SSI, LISP, and MSP) may automatically qualify for CSFP, without providing additional proof of income.

Eligibility: Seniors who wish to participate must reside in New Jersey, must provide proof of identity, age, residency, and house income at/or below 150% of the poverty level.
