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

On September 17, 2024, the Department of Health (hereinafter, "the Department") issued a Curtailment of Admissions Order to Belle Care Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, arising from the facility's admission of justice-involved residents who came with prison restrictions that were in conflict with CMS requirements. Today's order confirms that, effective September 27, 2024, the Department lifted the September 17, 2024, Curtailment of Admissions Order.
