

# TOPIC AREA GOALS





# HEALTHY FAMILIES

1. Eliminate the racial disparity in birth outcomes
2. Increase vaccination among children
3. Increase prenatal care across all race and ethnicities
4. Increase access to full spectrum services for families of all generations, complexities, and abilities
5. Decrease sexually transmitted diseases in adolescents and young adults



# HEALTHY LIVING

1. Improve self-care
2. Improve health by promoting healthy eating and physical activity
3. Increase timely access to quality behavioral healthcare

# ACCESS TO QUALITY CARE

1. Improve equitable and sustainable access to care
2. Ensure provision of high quality and safe healthcare
3. Assure coordination and integration of healthcare delivery across the continuum of care
4. Enhance data information exchange, interoperability, and telehealth across the health care continuum

# HEALTHY COMMUNITIES

1. Make health and health equity a priority in statewide strategic planning and policy
2. Increase available resources and capacity at the state and local levels to support efforts that are focused on addressing root causes of health inequities and health disparities
3. Make data regarding health outcomes and health factors available at a municipal or neighborhood level to support cross-sector, collaborative healthy community planning
4. Ensure that decision-makers (public, private, non-governmental) are informed about the health consequences of various policy options during the policy development process
5. Deploy new models for engagement of populations and communities most affected by health disparities as part of state and local planning, policy and decision-making
