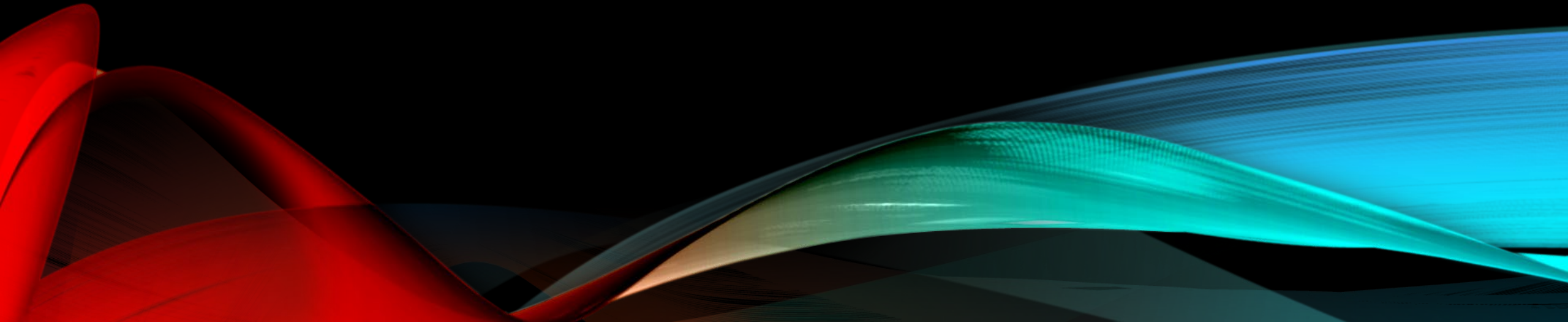

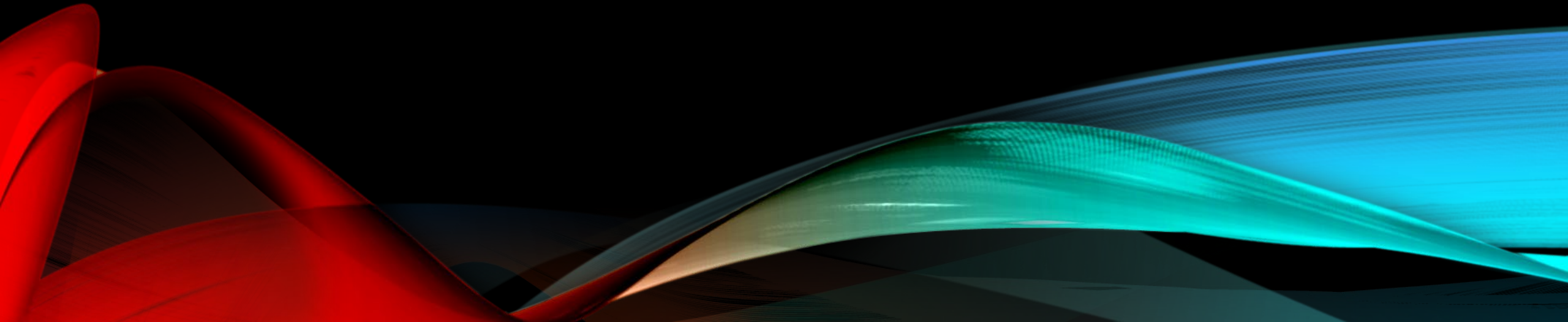

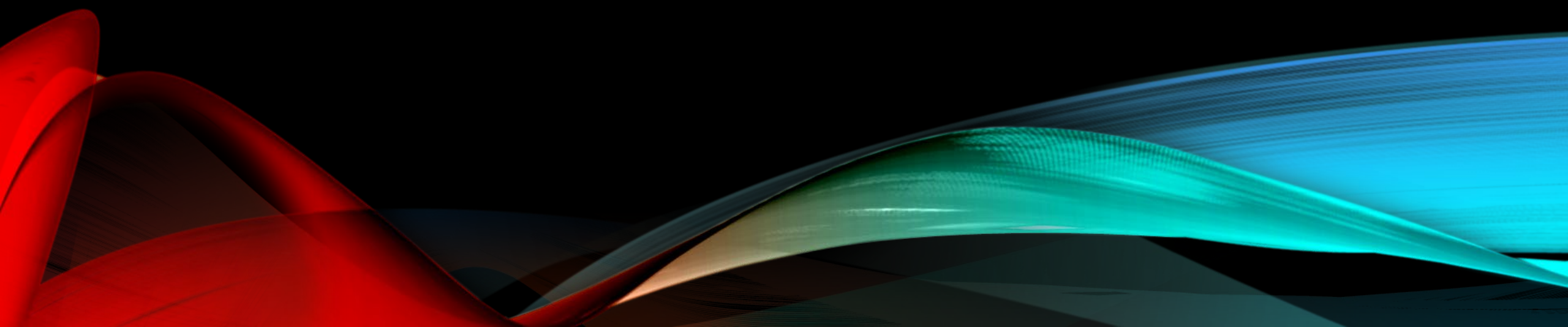
OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Nutrition/physical activity - include all ages - HL
2. SUD/MH – include harm reduction - HL
3. Prenatal care – include postnatal care – HF
4. Preventative care focus - AQC
5. Trauma-informed care - AQC
6. ACEs – HF (prevention)
7. Domestic violence – HF
8. Caregiver support – HF
9. Parenting resources – HF

OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS (CONT'D)

10. Vaccination - include all ages - AQC
11. Healthcare workforce/shortage - AQC
12. Local public health depts/infrastructure - AQC
13. Community-based organizations – all (don't forget about them)
14. Transportation to health care, public transportation - HC
15. Natural hazards (incl. air and water quality) - HC
16. Built environment - HC
17. Age-friendly communities - HC
18. Worker/occupational health & safety – HC (wages & “supportive environment”)

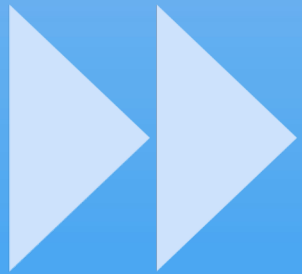

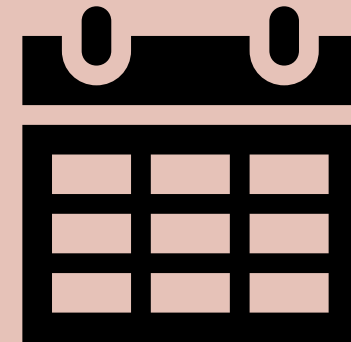
