ACTION TEAM RECRUITMENT

- 1. Agreed to do "rolling recruitment" starting with invitees and then applicants
- 2. Invitees:

 - Standardized email wording including timeline and time/meeting commitment to be provided to HNJAC members by Wednesday 12/18
- 3. Applicants:

 - b. Allow applicants to rank TA preferences on the application

FIRST ACTION TEAM MEETING

- 1. Guidelines to be written and provided to the tri-chairs before first meeting will include info about:
 - a. HP2030's Topic Area Selection Guidance (Step 1 on page 27)
 - b. Equity, policy, and climate are cross-cutting issues that are to be addressed in all TAs
 - c. HNJ2030 is not focused on outcomes, but is focused on upstream factors like determinants of health, prevention, etc.
 - d. HNJAC's brainstorming lists of what could go into each TA (all four lists to all four tri-chairs so everyone knows what's covered in other TAs)
- 2. ACTs will be making recommendations for the focus issues of each TA. HNJAC will make the final decisions together.





TOPIC AREA RATIONALE

- 1. Chairs will compose draft of Background Rationale.
 - a. After edits are made, draft will go to all HNJAC and HNJCC members for comments/edits.
- 2. After TA focus issues are finalized, each Topic Area rationale will be written to include:
 - a. Description of what focus issues are in the TA
 - b. Why those focus issues were chosen

- 1. 12/17/19: Chairs will give presentation to DOH senior staff about the work of the HNJCC thus far, how the HNJAC was formed, and what the HNJAC has done thus far (including the selection of the four TAs and three cross-cutting issues)
