- Between now and 5/20/22,
 - Review existing plans, strategies, and reports, including <u>SHIP 2020</u>, <u>Nurture NJ</u>, and the
 as yet unpublished breastfeeding strategic plan, to see what's already being done in NJ,
 so we don't reinvent the wheel or contradict other projects
 - Review HP2030 and other states' work for ideas
 - Look at quantitative and qualitative data, including <u>Community Conversations</u>
 - Brainstorm ideas for how to improve the health of mothers and babies in NJ, always keeping <u>equity</u>, <u>resilience</u>, social determinants of health (<u>SDOH</u>), and root causes in mind
 - Prioritize those ideas and select the top ones to include in the action plan (following guidance documents in Teams)
 - Send plan drafts to the HNJ email account along the way for review by the Advisory Council
