- ❖ Primary focus: Decrease morbidity/mortality, decrease disability, increase health equity/decrease health disparities, increase well-being
- ❖ Identify areas of overlap with other Action Teams
- ❖ Discussed need to review current status and identify gaps in focus areas identified
