IMPROVEMENT PLANS VS. STRATEGIC PLANS

	State Health Improvement Plan	Strategic Plan
Intent	External: Change risk factors and/or health outcomes	Internal: Assess and improve the infrastructure to “get the right things done, in the right way, with the right people / resources”.
<i>Example</i>	Decrease the exposure to environmental hazards	Modernize data infrastructure to improve the timely detection and prevention of public health threats
Ownership/ Responsibility	Public Health system in NJ and key partners; shared responsibility	Internal; NJDOH Leadership & Staff

PRIORITIZING ACTIONS

Must-have

Non-negotiable, this action is critical to achieve our objective.

Should-have

This action is important and adds value but is not critical to achieving the objective at this time.

Can-have

This action would be good to include, if time and resources permit, but it is not essential to achieving the objective.

Won't-have

This action is a low priority or not needed in the current plan.


