<p>Under supervision of the Assistant Director of Nursing Services, plans, coordinates, and carries out educational programs for all nursing personnel; orients new staff members and provides inservice refresher programs for professional nurses returning to hospital nursing service; provides lectures, and demonstrates new procedures for nursing service; prepares and issues trainee manuals which describe duties and responsibilities of nursing personnel to be used as training guides in orientation, refresher, and other nursing education programs. <p>EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Nursing or a Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in Nursing or a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing Education.</p> <p>EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of nursing experience which shall have included nursing instruction.</p> <p>NOTE: For applicants who do not possess the three (3) years of nursing experience, possession of a Master's degree in one (1) of the above mentioned areas may be substituted for one (1) year of the work experience.</p> <p>LICENSE: Registration or eligibility for registration as a Professional Registered Nurse in the State of New Jersey.</p> <p>Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.</p>
