#### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the general supervision of a higher level Registered Environmental Health Inspector or other supervisory official, plans and conducts inspections for the Wholesale Food and Drug Projects.

Writes reports covering violations and food processing operations of each establishment inspected.

Conducts comprehensive inspections and investigations of New Jersey licensed Wholesale Food establishments to assure compliance with N.J.A.C. 8:21-2.1 et seq. and the FDA MOA.

Conducts limited food emergency preparedness assessments to ensure continuity and availably safe drugs during emergencies and crises.

Prepares technical reports and memorandum which contains findings, conclusions, and recommendations. Maintains essential records and files.

Will be required to learn to utilize various types of electronic and/or manual recording and information systems used by the Public Health and Food Protection Program.

Represents the Department at appropriate meetings, conferences, workshops, etc.

ADVANCEMENT: Appointees who successfully compete the twelve-month training period will be eligible for advancement to the title for which they are being trained.

The inability of an employee in this title to attain a level of performance warranting advancement to a title listed above shall be considered as cause for separation.

### REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree including or supplemented by thirty-two (32) semester hour credits (undergraduate or graduate) in the biological sciences, physical sciences, environmental sciences, mathematics, or any combination thereof.

LICENSE: Applicants must possess a license as a Registered Environmental Health Specialist issued by the NJ Department of Health and Senior Services.

NOTE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.

PHEL Candidates:

If you are a candidate for a position in our Public Health and Environmental Laboratories, you may be subject to pre- and /or post-

employment alcohol and drug testing.

**Direct Client Care:** 

If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care in one of the State facilities/programs, you may be subject to pre- and/or post-employment drug testing/screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing will be at the candidate's expense. Candidates with a positive drug test result, or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the

testing requirement, will not be hired.

New Jersey First Act: In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14-7, the "New Jersey First Act", all employees must reside in the State of New Jersey, unless exempted under the law. If you do not live in New Jersey, you have one year after you begin

employment to relocate your residence to New Jersey.

**Resume Note:** 

Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.

**Authorization to Work:**
