GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Technical Assistant Personnel will be responsible for reviewing forms submitted for exemption approval for new positions in accordance with DOH procedures and New Jersey Administrative Code 4A. Will become familiar with using HRTrack, reviewing exemption requests for appropriate classification and verification of all required documentation.

This position will verify if there are any existing promotional or open competitive lists. Print and create folders for DPF-77/10 packages, ensure sure the package is complete; including the DPF-44, organizational chart, resume/credentials, and any necessary justification. Receive, log, and file all certifications. Compile responses from all candidates. Prepare and send certification package to the appropriate division.

The Technical Assistant, Personnel will work with Division HR Liaisons on a bi-weekly basis to ensure all DOH Organizational Charts are kept up to date. Prepare routine memorandums, reports, and correspondence as required in daily duties as they relate to classification and compensation. Prepares business objects reports for management on an as needed basis.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Completion of sixty (60) semester hour credits from an accredited college or university.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in technical, clerical personnel work involving the application of procedural rules, regulations, policies, and procedures.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
