GENERAL DESCRIPTION

DEFINITION: Under the medical director or other professional care program administrator, plans and supervises the institution care program and the professional Nutritionists assigned to the nutrition care program, in compliance with federal, state and department program standards. Supervises staff and work activities. Prepares and signs official performance evaluations for subordinate staff; does related work as required.

NOTE: The definition and examples of work for this title are for illustrative purposes only. A particular position using this title may not perform all duties listed in this job specification. Conversely, all duties performed on the job may not be listed.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

CERTIFICATION: NOTE: Applicants must possess a current and valid Certification as a Registered Dietitian (RD) or Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN) issued by the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in hospital dietetics or community nutrition, with an emphasis in clinical and/or therapeutic nutrition or in diet counseling services.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Food and Nutrition or Clinical Dietetics may be substituted for one (1) year of experience.

LICENSE: Applicants will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
