GENERAL DESCRIPTION			
<p>Under the supervision of the Executive Director of the Office of Long-Term Care Resiliency (OLTCR), this position will be responsible for managing and analyzing the LTC website and dashboard, analyzing and supporting the interoperability of all 657 LTC facilities across NJ, analyzing hot spots and trends in outbreaks, analyzing data acquired from external websites, federal reports, and CDC reports, collating data for report generation, and consulting with Mission Critical teams to define trends and deficiencies within the LTC community.</p> <p>This position will oversee evaluations and collation of data into reports, will summarize collectively appropriate interventions, and will create documents that will allow for interpretation and appropriate quality assurance measures to be taken.</p> <p>This position will interpret legislation and provide data-related support to the LTC task force.</p> <p>This position may be eligible to participate in the Department's pilot telework program, which offers eligible employees the opportunity to work remotely for up to two (2) days per week, as approved by management</p>
