<p>EDUCATION: Successful completion of 60 semester hour credits from an accredited college or university which shall have included 24 semester hour credits in the biological and/or physical sciences.</p> <p>EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience as a technician in a public health , hospital, clinic or research laboratory performing various types of tests.</p> <p>NOTE: Successful completion of a certificate program in Clinical Laboratory Technology may be substituted for the above education.</p> <p>NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required college or certificate in Clinical Laboratory Technology may substitute two (2) additional years of experience.</p> <p>LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver'S license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.</p>
