Notice of Cancellation of Certificate of Need Call for Mobile Intensive Care Unit Programs

Take notice that, in compliance with N.J.S.A. 26:2H-1 et seq. (P.L. 1971, c. 136, as amended), and pursuant to P.L. 1998, c. 43 (codified as N.J.S.A. 26:2H-7c), and N.J.A.C. 8:33, Kaitlan Baston, MD, MSc, DFASAM, Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Health (Department), hereby publishes notice that the certificate of need call for applications for mobile intensive care units (MICU) in accordance with the provisions at N.J.A.C. 8:33 and N.J.S.A. 26:2H-1 et seq., scheduled for June 1, 2025, is hereby canceled.

The issuance of a call at this time, absent a definite indication of additional need, would be premature. In accordance with departmental procedures, as set forth at N.J.A.C. 8:33-4.1(a), the Department, therefore, finds it necessary to cancel the call for MICUs. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 8:33-4.1(a)2, the next scheduled deadline for the submission of MICUs will be June 1, 2028.

The Department will continue to monitor the utilization and availability of MICUs and, should the need arise, issue a future call for MICUs prior to June 1, 2028.
